

The Correct Method of Putting Out Household Waste

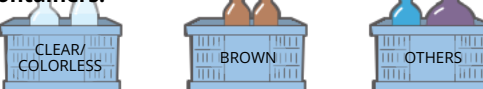
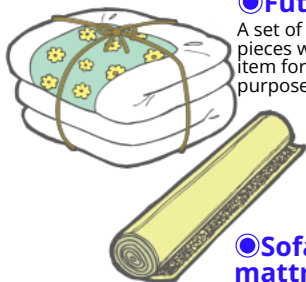
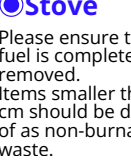
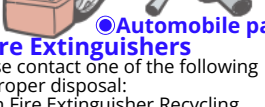
Please Help
Reduce Waste
and Recycle!

Please be sure to put out the garbage by **8:30 a.m.** on the collection day.

For items that do not follow the garbage disposal rules, such as "wrong collection day" or "waste not properly sorted," a violation sticker will be attached, and the garbage will be left at the collection site. If a violation sticker has been placed on the items you have put out, please promptly take them back, sort them correctly, and put them out again on the next collection day.

●The items listed below are only representative examples, so please make sure to dispose of all other items on their designated collection days.

PLEASE POST THIS IN A CLEARLY VISIBLE LOCATION!!

Burnable waste		Be sure to place your garbage in the officially designated town garbage bags and bring it to the collection site. --Items with any side longer than approximately 30 cm should be disposed of as bulky waste. ●Plastic products without the ♻️ mark should be disposed of as burnable waste. ●Plastic items with the ♻️ mark should be disposed of as recyclable waste.	●Food waste Please drain excess water thoroughly. Whenever possible, use composting or other methods to dispose of food waste at home. 		●Pruned branches, etc. (less than 5 cm in diameter) Please cut them to approximately 30 cm in length, place them in the designated town garbage bag, and set them out for collection. 	●Leather product Please be sure to remove any metal components. 	●Hose For long items, please be sure to cut them to about 30 cm in length. 	
Recyclable waste	Can	Please rinse with water to remove contents, place the item in a bag, and bring it to the garbage collection site.	●Drink cans, canned food cans, etc. 		Please remove the contents from spray cans, cassette gas canisters, paint cans, one-gallon cans, and other cans not listed above before disposing of them as non-burnable waste . 			
	Bin	Please remove caps and labels, rinse with water to remove contents, and without putting them in a bag, separate them by color and place them in the designated containers.	●Please separate empty bottles into three colors and place them in the appropriate containers. 		Please ask the store regarding pesticide bottles, bottles that contained special chemicals, and returnable bottles (such as beer or juice bottles). Lightly colored bottles should be sorted by color and placed in the appropriate containers. Milky white bottles, such as cosmetic containers, should be placed in the "clear/colorless" container. 			
	Used paper, cloth items, PET bottles, and plastic containers/packaging	★Since recyclable waste is taken to different processing facilities depending on the category, please make sure to separate each type and put them out individually. ●How to Dispose of Plastic Containers and Packaging ●Items with food residue should be thoroughly washed or wiped clean, dried, and then placed together in a clear or semi-transparent bag before being set out for collection. ●Plastic items that cannot be cleaned or are not classified as packaging should be disposed of as burnable waste. (Items exceeding 30 cm in size must be disposed of as bulky waste.) ●All items marked with the plastic ♻️ symbol are subject to this category.	On rainy days, only PET bottles and plastic containers/packaging will be collected. All other types of waste collection will be suspended, so please do not put them out. ●Plastic containers and packaging Plastic bags and wraps: Clear or semi-transparent bags, plastic snack wrappers, etc. Cups and similar containers: Pudding cups, jelly containers, etc. Pack-type containers: Such as egg cartons, tofu containers, and margarine tubs. Trays and bottles: Such as sauce trays and shampoo bottles. Crushed Styrofoam (cut into pieces 30 cm or smaller) 		●Newspapers Please tie in bundles with string or similar materials (do not use packing tape). 	●Milk cartons Cartons with silver lining on the inside should be disposed of as burnable waste. 	●PET bottles Please remove caps and labels, and dispose of them as plastic containers and packaging. 	●Used fabrics, clothing, and textiles Please place them in clear or semi-transparent bags. 
Non-burnable waste	●Please place small items, broken pieces, and glass tableware in a semi-transparent bag that allows the contents to be seen before setting them out for collection. ●Please remove the fabric from umbrellas before disposal. The removed fabric should be disposed of as burnable waste. ●Items with any side measuring 50 cm or more should be disposed of as bulky waste. Plastic items, such as buckets, should be reduced to under 30 cm in size and disposed of as burnable waste.	●Small household electrical appliances Please cut the cords and dispose of the items as non-burnable waste. 		●Cans other than beverage/food cans If there's oil or paint on it, make sure to clean it off before throwing it away. 	●Ceramic items 	●Metal caps and stoppers 	●Hazardous waste ●Light bulbs ●fluorescent lamps ●Mercury thermometers ●Dry cell batteries ●rechargeable batteries Please deposit dry batteries in the designated battery collection bins at the collection site. 	
Bulky waste/ Large-sized waste Please do not place items directly at the collection site under any circumstances.	●Burnable waste with any side measuring 30 cm or more , and non-burnable waste with any side measuring 50 cm or more , must be disposed of as bulky waste. ●As bulky waste is collected on an individual basis, residents wishing to arrange for collection are requested to apply in person during the designated application period (as indicated in the Matsuda Town Waste Collection Calendar) at the counter of the Environmental and Public Sewerage Division, Environmental Parks Section, or at the Yadoriki Branch Office. ●If you wish to bring bulky waste directly to the facility, please contact the Ashigara Eastern Sanitation Association at (83-1554) in advance to make a reservation. ●A maximum of five items may be included in a single application. A handling fee of 1,100 yen per item (tax included) will be charged. ●As some items may need to be disassembled in advance, please contact the Environmental and Public Sewerage Division, Environmental Parks Section for further details.		●Futons A set of up to three futon pieces will be treated as one item for collection and fee purposes. 		●Microwave oven Items under 50 cm should be disposed of as non-burnable waste. 	●Wooden furniture and steel furniture 	●Bicycle 	
	Items that cannot be collected	●Items that are not properly sorted. ●For large amounts of waste generated at one time, such as during a move, please either bring the waste directly to the facility or request collection from a licensed general waste collection and transportation contractor. ●Business-related general waste (such as that generated from restaurants, shops, companies, factories, etc.) is required by law to be disposed of by the business itself. Please either bring the waste directly to the facility or contract a general waste collection and transportation company authorized by the town. Please consult the place of purchase or a relevant party for proper disposal.	●Sofa, bed, and mattress Please remove the springs and disassemble the item. 		●Electric fan Items under 50 cm should be disposed of as non-burnable waste. 	●Stove Please ensure that all fuel is completely removed. Items smaller than 50 cm should be disposed of as non-burnable waste. 	●Septic tanks, bathtubs, and plumbing fixtures.

Collection will be carried out on public holidays, except during the May holiday period and the New Year holidays.

●Please make a reservation before bringing waste directly to the facility.

When disposing of waste due to moving or bulky items, those wishing to bring waste directly must contact the Ashigara Eastern Sanitation Association by phone no later than the day before. Please make a reservation by providing the desired delivery date, as well as the type and quantity of waste.

(Fees apply.)

The fee is 250 yen per unit, with one unit defined as up to 10 kilograms.

●How to Dispose of Specified Home Appliances

The disposal of televisions, air conditioners, washing machines, refrigerators (including freezers), and clothes dryers—as designated under the Home Appliance Recycling Law—is not handled by the town.

1. Request the store (retailer) to take back the appliance when purchasing a replacement.

2. Purchase a Home Appliance Recycling Ticket at the post office, attach the ticket to the applicable item, and bring it directly to a designated collection site.

3. If disposal by the above methods is not possible, please request transportation to a designated collection site from one of the general waste collection and transportation companies listed below. For details regarding fees, please contact each company directly.

●How to Dispose of Personal Computers (Laptop computers, desktop computers, and LCD monitors)

1. If your personal computer is no longer needed, please request disposal through the PC 3R Promotion Association or the manufacturer.

2. Please pay the collection and recycling fee using the specified method.

3. Please pack the computer in a box or similar packaging, and attach the shipping label provided by the manufacturer

4. Please either request a door-to-door collection through your nearest post office or bring the item directly to the manufacturer.

For CRT monitors, please request disposal through the PC 3R Promotion Association.

★When disposing of a computer, it is recommended that you take appropriate measures such as erasing all data from the hard disk.

●Drop-off Collection at Designated Sites

The following types of waste are collected at designated drop-off points.

◆PET bottles and plastic containers/packaging

●Matsuda Town Regional Revitalization Hub Facility (Suprapo)

Collection box located in the parking lot (Available every day / 24 hours)

◆Small Household Appliances (Devices with the longest side less than 30 cm that fit through an opening measuring 24 cm by 11 cm)

●Matsuda Town Hall

2nd Floor Central Collection Box (Weekdays / 8:30 AM – 5:15 PM)

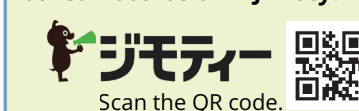
●Free distribution to residents. (One per household)

○Composters (Including tote bag types)
